Fresh SALSAS

Ingredients

- 6 medium size tomatoes, chopped
- 1/2 red onion, or sweet onion
- 3-4 fresh jalapeño peppers
- 1/2 bunch fresh cilantro
- 3 cloves garlic
- 2 Tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 1 1/4 teaspoons cumin
- 1 teaspoon Sea salt

Instructions

Add all ingredients to the bowl of a food processor. Pulse about 5-10 times, or just until the ingredients are finely diced, but stop before they're soupy. Pour contents into a fine mesh strainer to remove excess liquid. For best flavor, refrigerate at least 2-3 hours before serving. Keeps in the fridge for up to 1 week.
